#### Cowans Gap - Lakeside Trail, 1.5 mile loop

Type: Unpaved hiking trail

Difficulty Level : Easy

This scenic trail is part of Cowan's Gap State Park. It circles the lake and provides an easy walking path for all ages. Dogs are welcome but should be kept on a leash. Pack a lunch and stop by one of the many picnic areas or enjoy a swim at the beach!

#### Cumberland Valley Rail Trail - Shippensburg - (up to) 12.8 miles with mile markers along the way

Type: Walking trail, mostly paved with some gravel

Difficulty Level : Easy

**Suggested Starting Point:** Shippensburg Township Park, 304 Britton Rd, Shippensburg, PA 17257.

- Bathrooms on site
- 💙 Playgrounds
- Dog friendly dog park on site
- Picnic areas in park & benches along trail



This beautiful, quiet trail is easy to walk or ride and has plenty of places to rest along the way. Enjoy the sights and sounds of nature, but don't forget your buy spray - this trail is very wooded in places. Shippensburg Township Park is where the photo scavenger hunt items are found.

This loop provides a fantastic walking/running path! When you're finished, you can spend time enjoying all the fun activities the park has to offer. Meet up with friends and play a round of soccer or sand volleyball and have a picnic!

#### Old Reservoir Trail - 3 miles out & back

Type: Hiking Trail

Difficulty Level : Medium Technical

**Directions:** Turn into Caledonia State Park off Rt. 30. Continue 1 mile and park in stone parking lot off 233 North. (Pictured right)

#### 🥑 🛛 Good for trail running



This single trek trail goes along old reservoir/creek. It contains roots, rocks, and dirt and is classified as easy medium technical. Begin hike by walking through the wooden gate. Follow trail over metal bridge alongside creek, staying left. Climb up hill, stay right at top of hill. At opening take left into hidden single trek trail head. Follow trail 1.25miles to "S-turns" on 233. Turn and go back. Be prepared to cross a log over the creek around 1 mile into trail.

This 128 acre park has plenty of paved walking trails to enjoy. With playgrounds, basketball courts, pavilions and a dog park, you can spend all afternoon here!

#### **Renfrew Park**

Type: Paved Walking Trail and Unpaved Nature Trails Location: Waynesboro Pa 17268 Difficulty Level : Easy

Renfrew Museum & Park is composed of 107-acres of farmstead that includes history structures, the museum, visitors' center, hiking nature trails, and much more. There is a pavilion, several picnic tables, and a playground area. A great place to wander and explore! Pets are not allowed at this park unless dogs registered as a Renfrew Pet Pal.

### Otterbein Recreational Park-Walking Trail, .6 mile loop, (5x is about 5k)

Type: Paved Walking Trail Location: 13375 Welty Rd, Waynesboro Pa 17268 Difficulty Level : Easy

Otterbein Park is a beautiful family friendly place to walk. It has a flat, stroller/wheelchair accessible track and is home of the Stallion's football. If the kids get tired, a playground is within eye shot of the track.

### Greene Township Park - 1.6 miles of walking trails

Type: Paved walking trails Difficulty Level : Easy/Intermediate Location: 996 Elevator Street Scotland, PA 17254

- Picnic areas

Spend some time enjoying this beautiful, family friendly park. It is a little hilly in places. Play a game of volleyball or have a picnic after you complete your run/walk!

#### Antrim Township Park - 4 miles of trails

Type: Paved walking trails and unpaved hiking trails. Difficulty Level : Paved: Easy, Hiking: Easy/Intermediate Location: 12315 Grant Shook Rd, Greencastle, PA 17225.

- Playgrounds
- Dog friendly dog park on site
- Picnic areas

This park offers 4 miles of trails, playgrounds, a dog park, picnic pavilion and more. A perfect place to spend an afternoon! The paved walking path is marked with 1/10 mile markers. The hiking trails are a little more wooded so bring your bug spray along!

#### Cumberland Valley Rail Trail : Chambersburg - 3.2 miles out & back

Type: Paved walking

Difficulty Level : Easy

**Suggested Starting Point:** Parking lot on W. King St, Chambersburg PA 17201 Street

- Close to downtown shops & restaurants
- Wheelchair/stroller/bike friendly
- Partly shaded

This urban trail is easy to walk or ride and is conveniently located downtown. Enjoy a stop at the Ice Cream station near Lincoln Way W and admire the nearby creek! On Saturdays, the North Square Farmer's Market will be open from 8-12 nearby at Fort Chambers Park.
